Summary	The outcome of this current proposal is to determine the best format to communicate complex data about stroke care, as collected in the AuSCR and currently provided in the AuSCR Annual Report, in order for it to be made more accessible to the general public. Currently, the AuSCR only produces a high level (more technical) annual report designed to principally communicate with health professionals and government. Our main objective is to develop and pilot a lay summary report for consumers to communicate clearly on the quality of hospital care for stroke in Australia which is tailored to an audience of patients, their families and the public.
